## Zierbena



**Zierbena** is a small fishing port town that maintains its traditional charm and wonderful **fish and seafood grills**. It is located in a unique natural enclave on the Way of St. James. If you like **surfing**, catch a wave at the nearby la Arena Beach. There are also a great deal of **rowing** competitions in this town, and the rowing boats from here are some of the most acclaimed.



## Santurtzi



You can visit **Casa Torre Palace** (18<sup>th</sup> century) and its historical information centre. The Brotherhood of Fishermen building houses the **Santurtzi Itsasoa Museum**. In the summertime you can take a whale watching tour on the Bay of Biscay. Reservations required. A visit to one of the last traditional wooden fishing boats left on the Cantabrian Sea, the **Atunero Agurtza**, is another riveting option here.



## Portugalete

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**Portugalete** is a medieval town on the Bilbao Estuary; its Old Quarter is well worth a visit, as well as its Gothic-Renaissance Basilica of Santa María. You can walk along the estuary to **Salazar Tower** and enjoy the charm of the Plaza del Solar and its neoclassical gazebo.



## Sestao

An important port town with a past associated with the iron, steel, and shipping industries. You can take a look at a remnants of the decommissioned Altos Hornos de Vizcaya metallurgy facilities, the **blast furnaces**, named a historic monument by the Basque government.



## Bilbao



Supported by the estuary, Bilbao is a city known for its **avant-garde architecture** living alongside **traditional** architecture in perfect harmony. The estuary is what connects the city to the ocean and beaches. The city's Old Quarter, its Gran Vía high street and the major remodelling of Abandoibarra, the Guggenheim Museum, the new San Mamés stadium, its extensive shopping options, etc. make this one of the best cities to wander around and enjoy.



## Getxo



Getxo is a large municipality including the settlements of **Las Arenas, Algorta, Romo, Neguri, and Andra Mari**. We recommend taking a walk along the seaside. You'll be awestruck by the grandeur of the gentry palaces. Their refined British style demonstrates the relationships established between the British islands and the great business families in the area at the time. Another great idea is taking a swim at the elegant **Ereaga beach** or taking a stroll along its marina.



## Sopela



**Sopela** is the perfect place for **surfing**. Its beaches are flanked by breathtaking cliffs. Barinatxe-La Salvaje is a beach with its own dune system. Above Arriatera-Atxabiribil beach, you'll find a number of lively bars with great locations for watching the spectacular sunset.



## Plentzia and Gorliz



**Plentzia** is a triple threat: it's got an estuary, a beach with calm waters, and a marina. The bay, which it shares with **Gorliz**, offers a unique experience: wine tastings and underwater immersion at the world's first underwater winery and artificial reef. At the bottom of the bay you'll find the **petrified dunes** of Gorliz, from which you can walk to the **Gorliz Lighthouse**.



## Armintza



**Armintza** is a great place to enjoy seafood dishes made with tinned and salted fish from the town's long-standing canning companies as well as fresh fish from one of its artisanal fisheries. A small fishing port with an identity-defining seafaring past.



## Bakio



**Bakio** features Bizkaia's longest beach, which is great for **surfing**. This is a town that has known how to maintain a significant rural economy centred around caserío farmhouses. One result of this is the production and sale of **txakoli**, a young, refreshing, and quintessentially Basque wine, the history of which you can discover at the **Txakolingunea** Txakoli Winemaking Museum.



## Bermeo



A visit to **Bermeo** means immersing yourself in the culinary pleasure of marmitako tuna and potato stew and canned albacore, tuna, and anchovies. This incredibly charming fishing village has a long history of whaling, which you can learn about at the **Fishing Museum**. Going out for pintxos, visiting the old port, and enjoying the views of the cliffs and **Izaro island** from La Tala grove are all part of a great itinerary here.



## Mundaka



This **international surfing destination** has the longest left-breaking wave in Europe. Mundaka is set around the **fishing port**, the most picturesque spot in town and a place for gathering and enjoying the company of friends. Thanks to its strategic location, the **hermitage of Santa Catalina** oversees the comings and goings on the estuary and offers one of the best panoramic views you'll find on the coast of Bizkaia.



## Gernika



This small town is an icon recognized around the world thanks to Picasso's painting depicting the cruelty and senselessness of the Spanish civil war. The town is now a symbol of peace. It contains the **Assembly House** and its famous tree, a tribute to the rights and freedoms of the Basque people. The **People of Europe Park**, the **Peace Foundation Museum**, the **Basque Country Museum**, and **Santa María Church** are all worth visiting.

It is also home to famous peppers and beans. This town holds a market every Monday year-round and the large "**Last Monday in Gernika**" agricultural fair on the last Monday in October.



## Ea and Lekeitio



Before you reach Lekeitio, you'll find the magical village of **Ea**. It's a tiny fishing village with a small cove at the end of the estuary.

**Lekeitio** boasts a colourful port, a wide array of bars and restaurants, a legendary island, incredible, long beaches, and a majestic old quarter. The Gothic **altarpiece at Santa María de la Asunción church** is also noteworthy.



## Ondarroa

Its old quarter notably contains **Likona Tower**, **the church of Andra Mari** (both from the 15th century), and the old **Brotherhood of Fishing building**. As a very important fishing port, this is the perfect place to eat **fish and seafood**: marmitako tuna and potato stew, baby squid, roasted sea bream, hake, clams in green sauce, etc. It all pairs well with a **txakoli** from Bizkaia.

### Bizkaia Bridge

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**Bizkaia Bridge**, also known as the Hanging Bridge, has been a **UNESCO World Heritage Site** since 2006 and is the point of connection between the two banks of the estuary: the industrial, working class left bank and the residential, bourgeoisie right bank. You can cross it with your car on board its gondola or walk the vertiginous walkway above.



### Santa Catalina Lighthouse

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The Santa Catalina Lighthouse in **Lekeitio** is home to the Navigation Technology Information Centre. Its use of technology will allow you to learn the basics of navigation and even take a virtual boat ride, learn maritime signals, see the fishermen's high seas living conditions, and enjoy a beautiful sunset from the terrace.



### San Juan de Gaztelugatxe

Heading toward **Bermeo**, you'll find the islet of **San Juan de Gaztelugatxe**, one of the most spectacular spots on the Basque coast and a famous "Game of Thrones" filming location. After you go over a two-arch bridge, gather the strength you need to climb the 241 stairs to the small hermitage of San Juan. When you get to the top, don't forget to ring the bell three times, make a wish, and therefore drive away evil spirits.



### Gernika Assembly House

The Gernika Assembly House is the place where Bizkaia Council meetings are held. The building is a symbol of the town's resurgence after being bombed during the Spanish Civil War. That is why it is now an **emblem of peace and freedom**.

### Guggenheim Bilbao



Not only a museum, but also a symbol of the resurgence and modernity of Bilbao. You'll find travelling exhibitions from important art galleries as well as permanent exhibits that are sure to make an impression. A stroll inside and around the museum is well worth it.



### Itsasmuseum



This museum is located alongside **the estuary**. It offers exhibits on the sailing culture of Bilbao and Bizkaia as well as the region's people. The region's seafaring past forged an identity that is on display in this museum's exhibition spaces.



### Fishing Museum



Atop the Old Port of **Bermeo** is the historic **Ercilla Tower**, a national monument. It is home to the Fishing Museum, one of the few museums in the world dedicated exclusively to showing visitors the environment, lifestyle, work, and techniques of fishermen.



### Plasentia de Butrón Museum



The **Plasentia de Butrón** Museum, in the Old Quarter of **Plentzia** is inside a tower house. In January 1999, the Plasentia de Butrón Foundation inaugurated this museum to collect and display different elements of the Plentzia region's past.



### Rialia (Museum of Industry)



During the industrialization of the area of **Portugalete**, **the estuary** was the linchpin. **Rialia** Museum of Industry was founded as a historical and artistic space focused on recovering and disseminating the remnants of the area's industrial past.



### Txakolingunea Txakoli Winemaking Museum



With audiovisual and interactive resources, **Txakolingunea in Bakio** provides visitors with the opportunity to learn about the characteristics and the process of preparing txakoli, a singular, unique wine with a distinctive character. You can also see the evolution of the area's wineries and participate in a tasting.

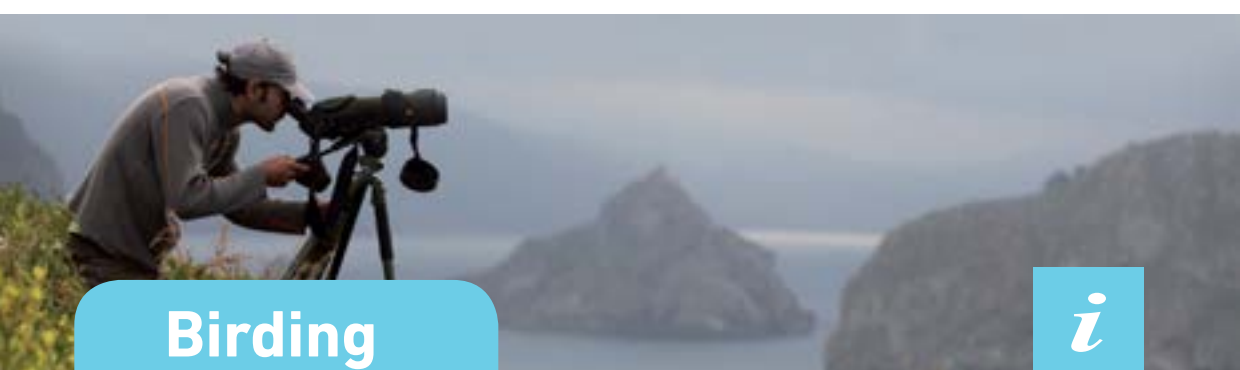

## Surfing



For beginners, we recommend Arriatera, Sopela, Bakio, Arrigunaga, Laga, and La Arena beaches. Experienced surfers should try Barinatxe – known as La Salvaje – Punta Galea, Meñakoz, and Izaro, whose 10 m wave is the largest in Europe. And of course, Mundaka is known around the world for its left-breaking wave.



## Birding



**Urdaibai Bird Centre** in Gauegiz-Arteaga is a research and exhibition centre that studies birds and their habitats to find a better way to protect flora, fauna, and nature in general. Every fall, **Abra** in Getxo becomes a favourite refuge for migratory birds. Out of **Santurtzi**, the company Verballenas organizes whale watching boat tours where you'll also be able to sight birds and cetaceans.



## MTB and Hiking



You can explore the coast from **Busturialdea-Urdaibai** and the surrounding area all the way to **Encartaciones** by bike. There are 14 routes for all levels as well as expert-only circuits. The route that goes **from Bermeo to Zugastieta** and the path that runs along the beautiful **Mundaka estuary** are particularly stunning, but whatever route you choose, you're sure to enjoy your outdoor activity in an unforgettable setting.



## Boat and Aquatic Tours

Whales, dolphins, and porpoises are easier to spot than you may think. 10-hour tours run out of Santurtzi to see dolphins, long-finned pilot whales, and orquals. Tours out of Bermeo often show visitors toothed whales, orca whales, and Cuvier's beaked whales (or calves), in addition to a number of types of dolphins and the above-mentioned long-finned pilot whales and orquals (whale).

## Tinned Food

The universal fame of the Basque fishing industry is demonstrated by the gourmet canning and salting industries. Albacore and tuna make up the bulk of production.



## Txakoli

A distinctive quintessentially Basque wine that has improved notably over the last few years with the modernization of wineries and production methods. A delicious wine generally made with hondarribi zuri grapes, it is frequently white, fruity, and refreshing.



## Seafood Pintxos and Dishes

The richness of the sea manifests itself in equally flavourful, globally recognized cuisine. Whether they're roasted, added to a more complex dish, or served up in miniature portions, Basque seafood is an undisputed delicacy. Hake á la ondarresa, albacore, marmitako tuna and potato stew, cod pil-pil, baby squid in ink sauce, and anchovies are all part of the wide array of delicacies available.



## Grills

The Basque Country's long tradition of grilling fish has made this dish a must-eat in Basque cuisine. Visit a grill (asadador) and ask the grill master for a recommendation. They are sure to offer you the best seasonal fish.

# Festivals and Events



There are plenty of sea-related festivals, celebrations, and events all over Bizkaia. Of particular interest are the festivals in Lekeitio, with the Kaxarranka dance and the madalenas, as well as the Cármenes and Sanpedros in any town, where blue is the festivities' official colour.

Sports competitions on the ocean are equally important. They include rowing, surfing, and sailing.
